**Zack Kline** The Star Tribune calls performer-teacher-composer Zack Kline a “versatile young violin ace” and the Minneapolis City Pages say he can sound like, “Grappelli here, Heifetz there, Vassar Clements over there.” Zack plays with the Orange Mighty Trio and has also played with Celtic with Katie McMahon, and Bluegrass with the Yonder Mountain String Band, among others. Zack runs the Chicago Fiddle Camp and has also taught at the Mark O’Connor Fiddle Camp, Rocky Grass Bluegrass Academy, and MacPhail Center for Music. Zack will teach jazz infused bluegrass this year.

**Margaretha Mattsson** comes to us from Orsa Sweden, in the Dalarna region, where she teaches traditional Swedish fiddle. Margaretha directs the Vikarbyns Lilla Spelmanslag, consisting of youth fiddlers, some of whom will be traveling to the U.S. to be part of the camp. Always a favorite, Margaretha has travelled to the United States multiple times and hosted joint workshops with the YFA.

**Robin Nelson** has been leading community folk dancing since 1985. She often includes songs and story telling in her presentations. She is a well known caller at the Tapestry Folkdance Center, and plays the banjo, penny whistle, autoharp, and dulcimer. She has been the enthusiastic dance instructor for most of our camps.

**Judy Kjenstad** Judy is a Twin Cities artist who has studied decorative folk art painting for over 20 years, including a commission for the mural exterior of Ingebretsen’s. She is a Vesterheim Gold Medal rosemaler who has worked on such large-scale designs as the Epcot center Norway Pavilion in Orlando, Florida, and the Black Forest Inn in Minneapolis. Judy also loves to play the nyckelharpa. Judy will be teaching Swedish painting in the Dalarna style.
